- 24/7 operation
- 15 sworn positions 6 dispatchers
- Cowell wellness center
- Contacting public safety (209)946-3911 and over 100 emergency blue phones on campus
- Back of your ID card will also have numbers
- Patrol campus and investigate property crimes
- STRIPE escort service
- 3 blocks off campus in each direction
- 500 security cameras across campus
- Personal safety as well as using stripes
- Also on social safety
- Cable lock thefts but not on U locks
- Arrest petty theft

- Southwest building and calaveras has bike locks
